Re: Spring Visit and Sample Collection



Green #12

Summary of lab data:

- *Tees and Fairways have seen a steady increase in areas you have worked on since you arrived. Add Epsom Salts in all tee and fairway spray tank mixes. I don't believe a granular fertilizer is necessary this Spring.*
- *Greens soils data was very good. Apply one 2 pounds of product rate application of 0-0-50 and one 10 pounds of gypsum at aerification.*

Dear Kent,

The biggest effect the course has had this Winter was rain and even some snow. I expected to see greens a little lean in available nutrition and they were. There is no hurry to reload as I thought things looked healthy. I did include a picture of #12 where we saw drill and fill holes from Fall. It shows how dry that particular green can be. The recovery may be slower on that green but the others were fully recovered. We did discuss the topdressing sand and after reviewing it, I would recommend continuing with the 3 Times washed sand from Pioneer. I don't see any reason not to and you are continuing to change the profile. We have testing from 2018 and we can check a random sample from your pile in 2020.

The tees and fairways have showed steady gains in areas we set out to change in 2015. If you are committed to the STS line of products this year, continue on a routine spray program and add Epsom salts to each tank. Ideally, you do a tank of Epsom salts and "pHacid" or "Blast" every 3-4 weeks, but if the STS line will handle the lower pH from the acid, spray it all at once.
