Summary of lab data:

- *Tees and Fairways have increased in all the nutrient levels you have worked on in the last 2 years. Manganese is low and you could spend time in the Fall and late Winter increasing that to help with the Fairy Ring.*
 - *Greens soils data was very good. Apply one 2 pounds of product rate application of 0-0-50 each month.*
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Dear Scott,

The numbers were really good and the course showed it! Everything you have done since the Jean Material was laid down has worked to make it a fertile ground- by Las Vegas standards. The nitrogen numbers were low on the tees and fairways on all testing. That should set things up nicely to be able to make some 21-0-0 applications to the bermudagrass this Summer. The soil temperatures were slightly lower year over year but by now you should be caught up. Sodium is no concern at this point due to the potable water usage and the Jean Material is draining well still. Keeping it cultivated through Summer is critical to Fall and Winter conditions being kept at the standard you have. The potable water still has the Bicarbonate issue and that has increased in the soil since June of 2018.

The greens are great as usual. It will be easy to start skipping good cultural practices for golf events or management decisions, but I have seen this time in a new green's life as an important time to do even more. Las Vegas ages things unlike any place else, as you know. I would recommend even more aerifications and beginning to work on adding varied depths at this point.
