Although the grass can be fixed, it will delay your opening by a week or so. You were already beginning to sod areas where they drove on the greens. I hope that the meeting you had with the insurance company will go well in your favor so that you can get some help with the expenses and extra labor. Of course, the whole thing is more disappointing than anything else. The bermudagrass had a great Summer and the greens were rolling excellent the day I was there.

As far as fertility is concerned, things are really in good shape. It was nice to see the sodium levels a little lower in the tees and fairways. The rainy Summer helped to flush things clean. The greens were a little higher in sodium year over year but nothing that the grass can't handle. I think that with the greens it is a function of the mix that is made to hold on to things longer than it really should.
